

School Uniform

It is important to us that our children represent the school well and that they are smart in appearance both at school and on the journey to and from school. We therefore ask that you support us in achieving this image and promoting our school in the local community.

All uniform must be labelled.

Uniform requirements

Summer:

Blue checked dress
Grey shorts or trousers
White polo shirt
Blue round-necked GBS logo sweatshirt or cardigan
White socks to be worn with dresses and skirts
Grey or black socks to be worn with shorts or trousers
Black shoes (sensible design, not slip-ons nor trainers)

Winter:

White polo shirt
Grey skirt, pinafore or trousers
Blue round-necked GBS logo sweatshirt or cardigan
White socks or grey tights to be worn with pinafores or skirts
Grey or black socks to be worn with trousers
Black shoes (sensible design, not boots nor trainers)

PE:

Blue GBS logo t-shirt
Blue shorts
Trainers for outdoors
Navy blue, plain, jogging bottoms and sweatshirt may be worn outside during cold weather
Logo drawstring PE bags are available to purchase
Socks (Tights can not be worn for PE)

No jewellery should be worn apart from a watch (not smart/wifi watches)

Children with pierced ears should wear PLAIN STUDS only and must be able to remove them by themselves for PE lessons or not wear them on PE days.

All hair that touches or is longer than shoulders, must all be tied back and hair, including fringes and should not cover children's eyes. Children can not wear large, coloured hair accessories, they must be modest in size and school colours (e.g. blue, black or white)

All Infant children will need a GBS bookbag.
